He loved working in the orchards, restoring old cars and spending time at the water in the summertime. Anyone who met Hubert enjoyed his quick wit and sly, funny jokes. Whenever times got tough, Hubert was always supportive of those around him, telling people "Kopf hoch". Hubert's dreams of a long life in Canada with his wife were cut short a few short months after his permanent residence status was granted, when he was diagnosed with terminal cancer. Hubert refused to let this diagnosis define the last few years of his life, following his heart and living his last years his own way with no fear of what was to come. He was very brave and fought a hard battle, independently. He loved his family and friends, cherishing every minute spent together.
